

Descendancy Narrative of Peter Gordon (228)

I. Peter¹ Gordon (228) was christened on 18 Jan 1784 at Kirkmabreck, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹ He married Mary McClure (239) on 27 Oct 1808 at Twynholm, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.² He married Mary Gracie (229), daughter of Robert Gracie (351), on 5 Jul 1818 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³ He was Joiner in 1837 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁴ He and Mary Gracie (229) appeared on the census of 7 Jun 1841 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁵ He and Mary Gracie (229) appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1851 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁶ He died on 31 Mar 1860 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁷ His estate was probated on 7 Jul 1860 at Kircudbright, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁸

A. George² Gordon (234)⁹ was christened on 19 Jul 1819 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹⁰

B. John² Gordon (236) was christened on 6 Feb 1820 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹¹ He lived on 6 Jul 1860 at Muthill, Perthshire, Scotland.¹²

C. James² Gordon (365) was born in 1822.¹³ He appeared on the census of 7 Jun 1841 in the household of Peter Gordon (228) and Mary Gracie (229) at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹⁴

D. Peter Murray² Gordon (227) was christened on 19 May 1822 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹⁵

E. Janet² Gordon (235)¹⁶ was christened on 21 Dec 1823 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland. She appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1851 in the household of Peter Gordon (228) and Mary Gracie (229) at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹⁷

F. Margaret² Gordon (364) was born in 1826. She appeared on the census of 7 Jun 1841 in the household of Peter Gordon (228) and Mary Gracie (229) at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.¹⁸

G. Joseph Black² Gordon (237)¹⁹ was born on 18 Apr 1827 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland. He was christened on 2 May 1827 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.

Grace² Gordon (231) was born on 5 Apr 1829 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²⁰ She was christened on 12 Apr 1829 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²¹ She appeared on the census of 7 Jun 1841 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²² She married James McQueen (353) in 1848. As of 1848, her married name was McQueen (231). She and James McQueen (353) appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1851 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²³ She and James McQueen (353) appeared on the census of 3 Apr 1871 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²⁴ She died on 10 Apr 1893 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland, aged 64.²⁵



I. Samuel² Gordon (8)²⁶ was born on 26 Sep 1831 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²⁷ He was christened on 9 Oct 1831 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland. He appeared on the census of 1841 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²⁸ He appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1851 in the household of Peter Gordon (228) and Mary Gracie (229) at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.²⁹ He married Janet Heyden Bell (9), daughter of Robert Bell (254) and (--?--) Mary Kerr (330), on 17 Jul 1857 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³⁰ He and Janet Heyden Bell (9) appeared on the census of 7 Apr 1861 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³¹ He and Janet Heyden Bell (9) appeared on the census of 3 Apr 1871 at House No. 5, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³² He and Janet Heyden Bell (9) appeared on the census of 3 Apr 1881 at High St, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³³ He and Janet Heyden Bell (9) appeared on the census of 5 Apr 1891 at Diamond Row, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³⁴ He and Janet Heyden Bell (9) appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1901 at 1 Queen St, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.³⁵ He died on 1 May 1907 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland, aged 75.³⁶

of 3 Apr 1871 in the household of Samuel Gordon (8) and Janet Heyden Bell (9) at House No. 5, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁴⁰ She married George Cowan Murray (331), son of Robert Murray (332) and (--?--) Mary Cowan (333), in Nov 1881.⁴¹ As of Nov 1881, her married name was Murray (1). She died on 15 Oct 1882 at Cameron Place, Dumfries, Dumfrieshire, Scotland, aged 24.⁴²



a) Robert Carr⁴ Murray (205)⁴³ was born on 11 Oct 1882 at Cameron Place, Dumfries, Scotland. His mother died 4 days after his birth and he was raised by his maternal grandparents.⁴⁴ He appeared on the census of 5 Apr 1891 in the household of Samuel Gordon (8) and Janet Heyden Bell (9) at Diamond Row, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁴⁵ He appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1901 in the household of Samuel Gordon (8) and Janet Heyden Bell (9) at 1 Queen St, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁴⁶ He married Isabella Wilson (207), daughter of Robert Wilson (315) and Mary Hastings (322), on 1 Jun 1906 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁴⁷ He and Isabella Wilson (207) appeared on the census of 2 Apr 1911 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire. Occupation of Robert was a Blacksmith.⁴⁸ He witnessed the death of George Cowan Murray (331) on 21 Jan 1932 at Islesteps, Dumfrieshire, Scotland.⁴⁹ He was named Executor in the Will of Peter Gordon on 12 Jul 1939 at Dumfries. He witnessed the death of Peter Gordon (39) on 2 Jun 1944 at Roseneath, Shawhead, Irongray, Kirkcudbrightshire.⁵⁰

2. Janet³ Gordon (38) was born on 30 Dec 1859 at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁵¹ She appeared on the census of 7 Apr 1861 in the household of Samuel Gordon (8) and Janet Heyden Bell (9) at Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁵² She appeared on the census of 3 Apr 1871 in the household of Samuel Gordon (8) and Janet Heyden Bell (9) at House No. 5, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁵³ She appeared on the census of 3 Apr 1881 at 5 George St, Dumfries, Dumfrieshire. Occupation was Domestic Servant in household of Miles Leighton, Wholesale Merchant.⁵⁴ She married Robert Dempster (253), son of William Dempster (371), after 3 Apr 1881. As of after 6 Sep 1889, her married name was Dempster (38) Dempster appears on birth registries for children after William's Birth. She was found on a passenger list on 23 Sep 1894 at Southampton, England.^{55,56} She appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1901 at 2 Diamond Row, Balmaclellan, Kirkcudbrightshire,

Scotland.⁵⁷ She was Laundress according to census on 31 Mar 1901. She appeared on the census of 2 Apr 1911 at 63 Colton St., Castle Douglas, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁵⁸ She married William Cumming (329) in 1913.⁵⁹ As of after 1913, her married name was Cumming (38). As of 4 Apr 1922, Janet Gordon (38) lived at 4 Millbrae, Maxwellton, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁶⁰ She died on 21 Nov 1931 at Brodie Avenue, Dumfries, Dumfrireshire, Scotland, aged 71.⁶¹ She was buried after 21 Nov 1931 at Troqueer Cemetery, Dumfries, Scotland.

a) George^d Dempster (203) was born on 14 Sep 1891 at Quincy, Massachusetts, USA.⁶² He was found on a passenger list with Janet Gordon (38) on 23 Sep 1894 at Southampton, England.^{63,64} He appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1901 at 151 King St, Castle Douglas, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁶⁵ He appeared on the census of 2 Apr 1911 at New Abbey, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁶⁶ He married Jessie Jane Saunders (327), daughter of John Saunders (340) and Marion Dempster (341), after 2 Apr 1911. He began military service circa 1915 at Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁶⁷ He was buried after 1960 at Troqueer Parish Churchyard, Dumfries, Scotland.⁶⁸

(1) Elizabeth⁵ Dempster (343) was living on 12 Jul 1939.

(2) Muriel Murray⁵ Dempster (328) was born in 1942.⁶⁹ As of 1943, she also went by the name of (328) May ?? She died on 19 Jun 1963 at Elizafield, Collin, Dumfries, Scotland.⁷⁰ She was buried after 19 Jun 1963 at Troqueer Parish Churchyard, Dumfries, Scotland.⁷¹

b) Mabel⁴ Dempster (202) was born on 22 Feb 1886 at Quincy, Norfolk, Mass, US.⁷² She was found on a passenger list with Janet Gordon (38) on 23 Sep 1894 at Southampton, England.^{73,74} She appeared on the census of 31 Mar 1901 in the household of George Dempster (203) at 151 King St, Castle Douglas, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁷⁵ She was employed circa 1904 at Threave Castle, Kirkcudbrightshire, Scotland.⁷⁶ She was employed circa 1923 at Church of England Mission Hospital, Krishnagar, India. She died on 25 Jan 1939 at Zenana Medical Mission Hospital, Krishnagar, India, aged 52.⁷⁷ She was buried after 25 Jan 1939 at Troqueer Parish Churchyard, Dumfries, Scotland. She was New Tag in Dec 1952 at Zenana Medical Mission, Krishnagar, India.⁷⁸



c) William Robert⁴ Dempster (230) was born on 6 Sep 1889 at Quincy, Massachusetts, USA.⁷⁹ He was born on 24 Sep 1889 at Quincy, Massachusetts, USA. He was found on a passenger list with Janet Gordon (38) on 23 Sep 1894 at Southampton,

The following article, clipped from "The Standard" of Dumfries, Scotland, tells of a memorial erected in India in honor of Sister Dempster, a niece of Mrs. W.C. Thompson of the Mount View district.

"A memorial in the form of a new ward for babies in the maternity section of the Zenana Medical Mission at Krishnagar, India, has been erected in honor of Sister Dempster, who for 16 years was a devoted member of the mission staff.

"The building was put up to add to the efficiency of the workings of the hospital. Friends of Maybelle Dempster sent money to put towards any memorial that might be raised, and the gifts were quite unasked for. His Excellency the governor of Bengal sent a grant of 500 rupees and the commissioner of that division sent 250 rupees. With the amount given for the memorial to Sister Dempster, it was possible to put up the babies' ward, a verandah and a new bathing and sanitation 'system for the mothers.

"Nothing could be a more fitting memorial to Sister Dempster as she was particularly devoted to babies and little children. She worked at the mission for 16 years and was finally nursed by the nurses she herself had trained."
